



Overview of Permissions

Student Profile Settings

- The same district restrictions and filters apply to iPads as Chromebooks.
- Students can access YouTube with filters and restrictions in place.
- Students can change their iPad background.
- Students can set a passcode. The district can unlock the passcode, if necessary.
- Students can download apps from a list curated by teachers and the district.
- Students will not have access to the App Store at all.
- Students can remove and organize their apps.
- Students will have access to the iPad's camera.
- No access to *any* social media will be available - app or web based.
- No iMessaging/texting will be available.
- No FaceTime will be available.
- No AirDrop will be available outside of Apple Classroom.
- Parents can oversee the device by downloading the app, ScreenGuide.
